

Coloreel Studio Release Notes SW1.5.29

Stable Release. Release date: 2023-06-14

General

This Coloreel Studio version is a corrective release to fix customer and stability issues.

Main Fixes

- Correction of generation of thumbnail and export to picture.

Minor Fixes

- Rendering. Display issue related to needle change for Multithread.
- Shortcuts. Correction of non-functional shortcuts related to changing section stitch limits.
- Stability. Several corrections.

Known limitations

- Library: A solid color from a library cannot be applied to a Standard thread.
 - Workaround: Select applicable color from the color picker.
- Rendering can be inaccurate which can provide an incorrect representation of the final embroidery.
 - Workaround: None (awareness)
- Timeline: The representation of swatches in the timeline can be inaccurate. This has been seen for: small files with stripe effect.
 - Workaround: None (awareness). Correct in design overview.
- Keyboard shortcuts. Alt-Z. First segment in timeline is not possible to cut with short-command.
 - Workaround: functionality accessible by other means
- Apply Swatches to timeline: Sometimes a drag-and-drop or ctrl-v to a section is not applied as expected.
 - Workaround. Redo related action to the section.
- Multiple section selection: The multiple section selection does not always select/mark all swatches of the same instance.
 - Workaround: None (awareness)
- Section resize: When changing the section boundaries it can sometimes jump to the end point.
 - Workaround: Section is very small and can be accessed by the user (might need to zoom in on timeline). Undo can also be used to correct unwanted resizes.
- Response time: Coloreel Studio can sometimes be slow in response. Especially for designs with many sections.

- Workaround: Close and start of program can increase performance (remove undo/redo possibilities that effect performance). HW (Computer) can also impact performance.
- Multithread: For a standard thread section a user can apply through menu "Insert/<swatch effect>" so that it seems as the section has an Coloreel thread effect applied to it. This effect is only visual in Coloreel Studio. Thread will be interpreted as a standard thread.
 - Workaround. Save of file and then close Coloreel Studion program and re-open file.
